
How to Assemble an Under Bench Oven Unit

Tools Required:







Cordless Drill



Mallet

Step 1:

Collect all of the required parts for your goFlatpacks product. You will need:

- 1. Bottom Panel
- 2. Sub-Bottom Panel
- 3. Right Side Panel
- 4. Left Side Panel
- 5. Front & Back Top Rails
- 6. Wood Screws
- 7. Adjustable Feet (if included)



Step 2:

The first parts you will be working with are the **Bottom Panel** and the Left Side Panel.



Step 3:

Glue along the bottom edge of the **Left Side Panel** and lift your **Left Sid**e and **Bottom Panel** up to create an L Shape.

Square off your panels and ensure the edges are flush before affixing in place with Wood Screws.



Step 4:

Repeat the process of gluing and screwing with the **Right Side Panel**.



Step 5:

Next, take your **Front Top Rail**, align with the screw holes on the top of your **Side Panels** and affix with Wood Screws.

Remember to drill pilot holes in your rails to avoid splitting the wood.

Step 6:

Glue along the edges of the **Back Top Rail**, ensure it is sitting flush with the edges of the cabinet carcase and then screw into place.





Step 7:

To set the height of the **Sub Bottom Panel** which your oven will sit on, grab your front fascia fixing.


This is the thin piece of wood that is the internal length between the **Left** and **Right Side Panels** of your cabinet.

Step 8:

Place the fascia fixing on the bottom, flush up against the **Side Panel**.

The bare edge of the fascia fixing will face towards the top of the cabinet.





Step 9:

Glue along the bare edges of the **Sub Bottom Panel** and place on the inside of the inside carcase.

Step 10:

Using your hands, manoeuvre the panel so that it is sitting tight with the fascia fixing, but the fixing can still be inserted and removed.





Step 11:

Move the fascia fixing along towards the opposite **Side Panel**, checking to see if the spacing is even. Again, the spacing should be close but not overly tight.

Step 12:

Using the Wood Screws, affix the Sub Bottom Panel to the Side Panels.





Step 13:

The **Sub Bottom Panel** is held in place by more screws than your **Bottom Panel**.

This is to provide extra support for the weight of your oven.

Step 14:

Your front fascia fixing will now slow into place in between the **Sub Bottom Pane**l and the **Bottom Pane**l, ready for your exterior panel to be attached to it.





Step 15:

Congratulations! You have assembled your goFlatpacks Under Bench Oven Unit.
